The heat treatment performed on fasteners depends on the specification requirements for a given application. While perhaps not the most significant cost element, heat treating is critical to achieving proper quality and performance. This seminar is intended to discuss the practical aspects of fastener materials, metallurgy and heat treatment. A solid understanding of the science behind the process will also be included. Topics will include the most common heat treatment techniques for fasteners such as hardening (furnace and induction) and case hardening (carbonitriding and carburizing). Various methods of quenching and tempering will also be covered. Ample time will be given for audience interaction on questions about common heat treat problems. A number of tips and techniques will be offered regarding the heat treatment of fasteners including a presentation on the influence of hydrogen attack in the form of embrittlement, responsible for a surprising number of delayed fastener failures.
