Hillman Solutions Invests in New Customer Support Center

The FDI remained steady last month at 52.7 versus the April reading of 52.6, seasonally adjusted. Likewise, the Forward Looking Indicator (FLI) showed little movement at 55.4 versus 55.1 the previous month. Remaining in growth territory, the reading remains strong and marks the 24th consecutive month of positive (+50.0) outlook.




